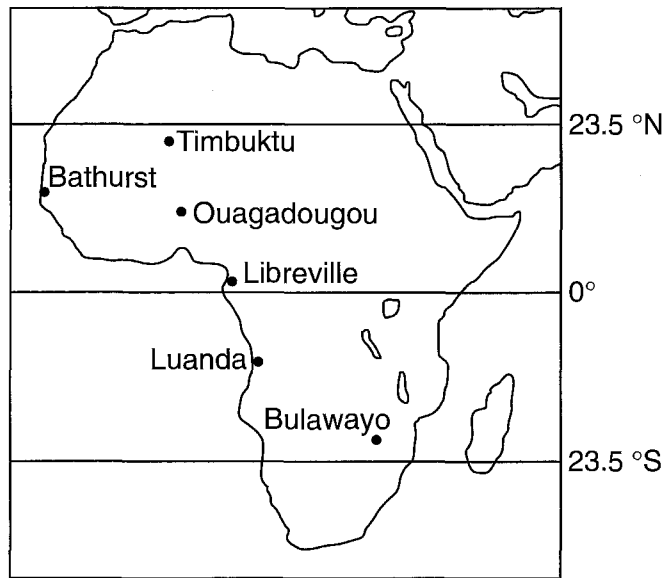

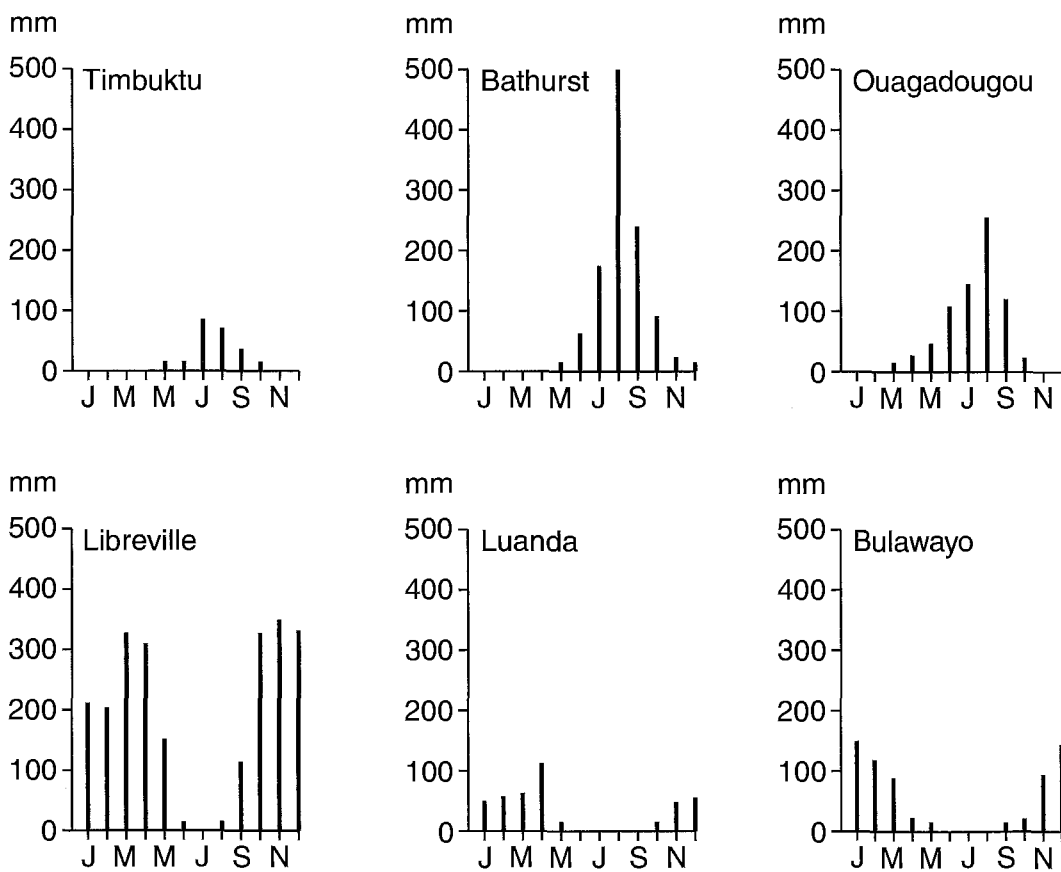

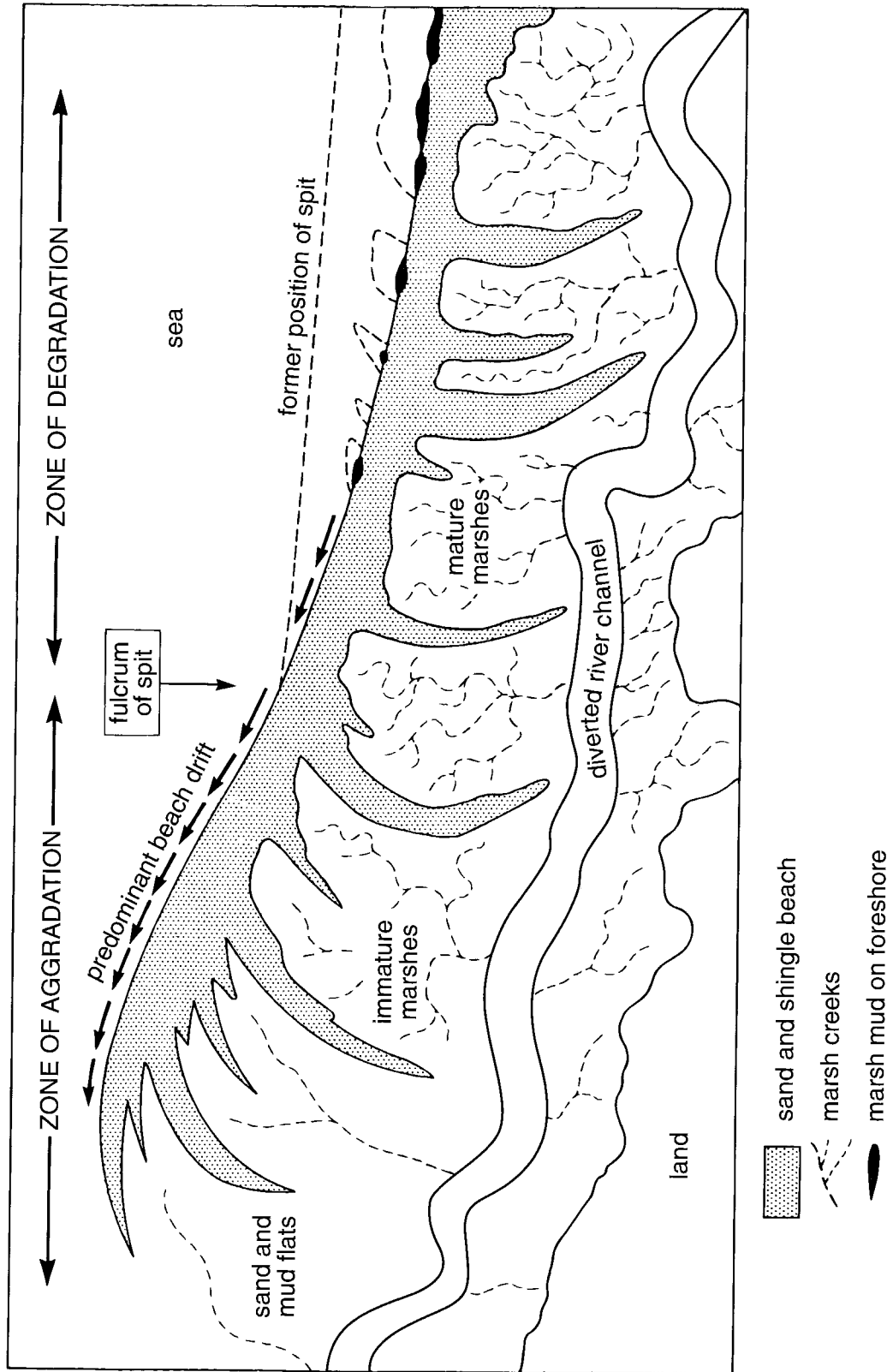
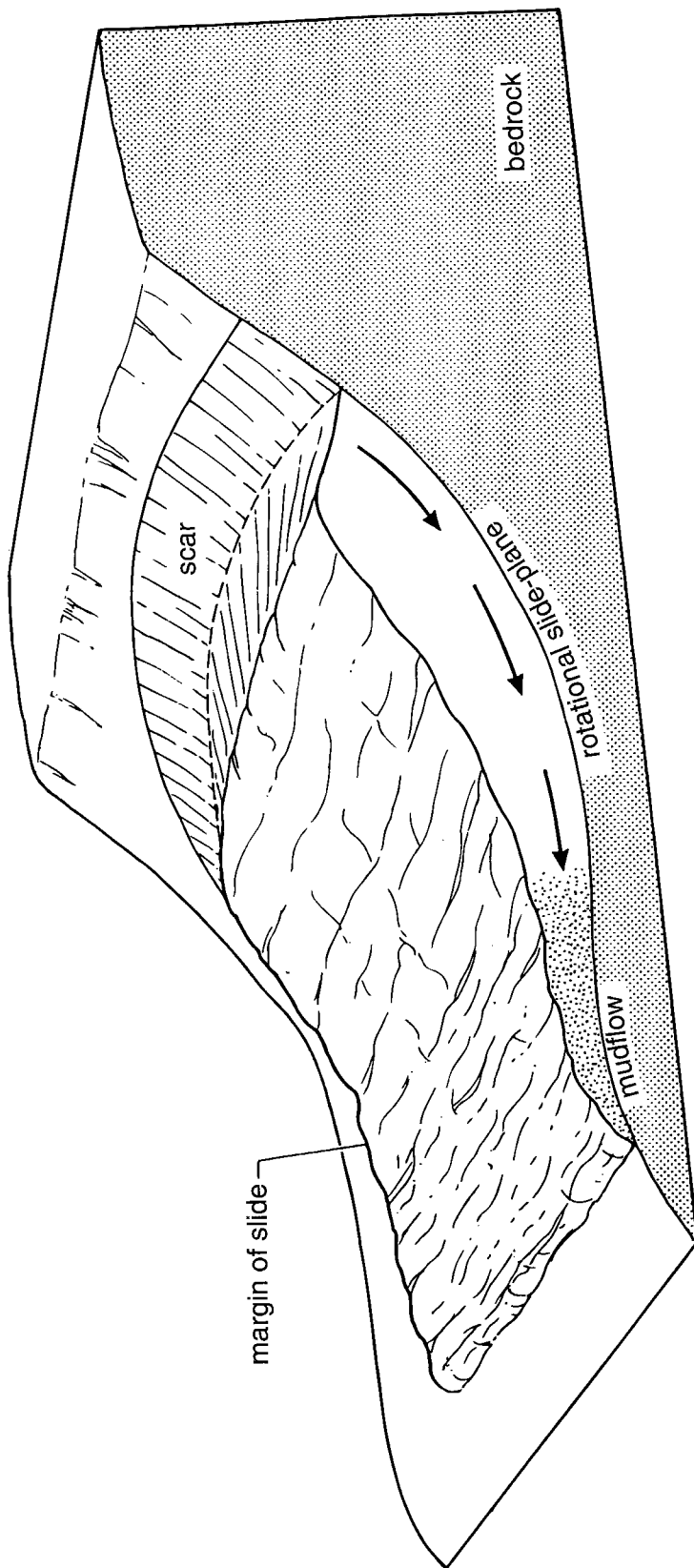
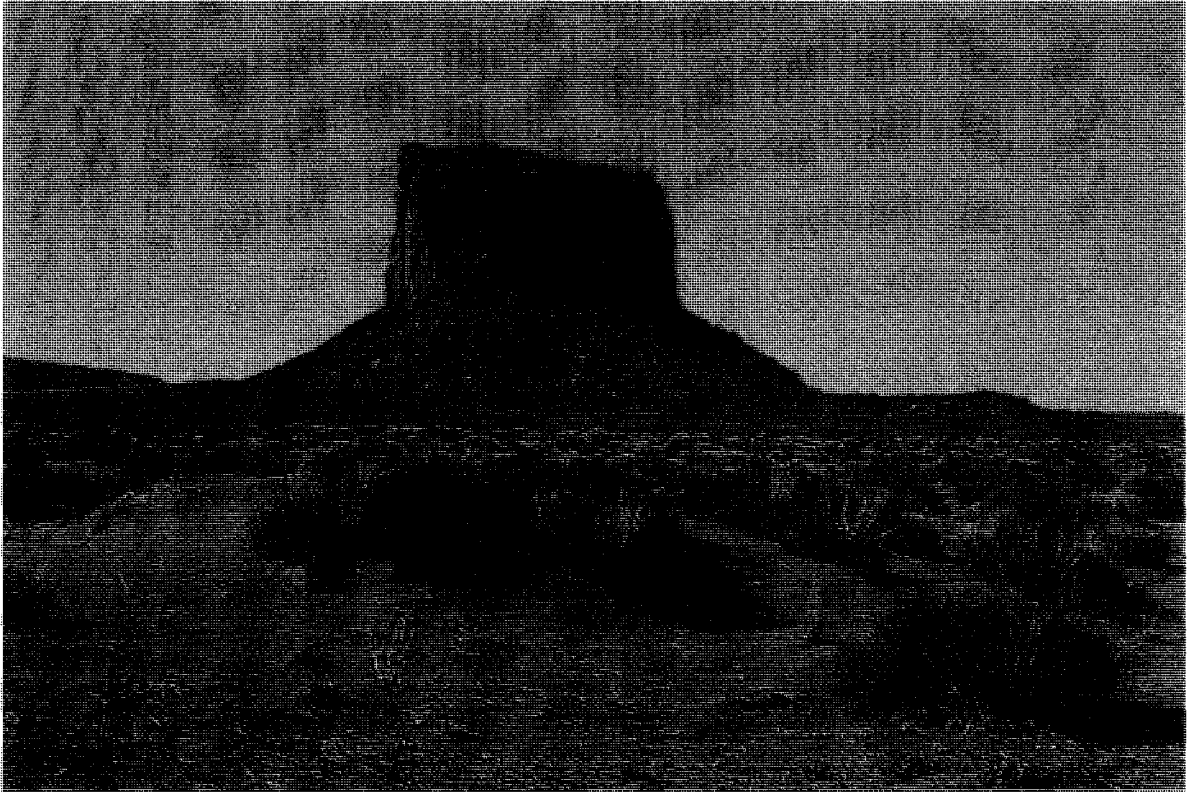

A typical landslide

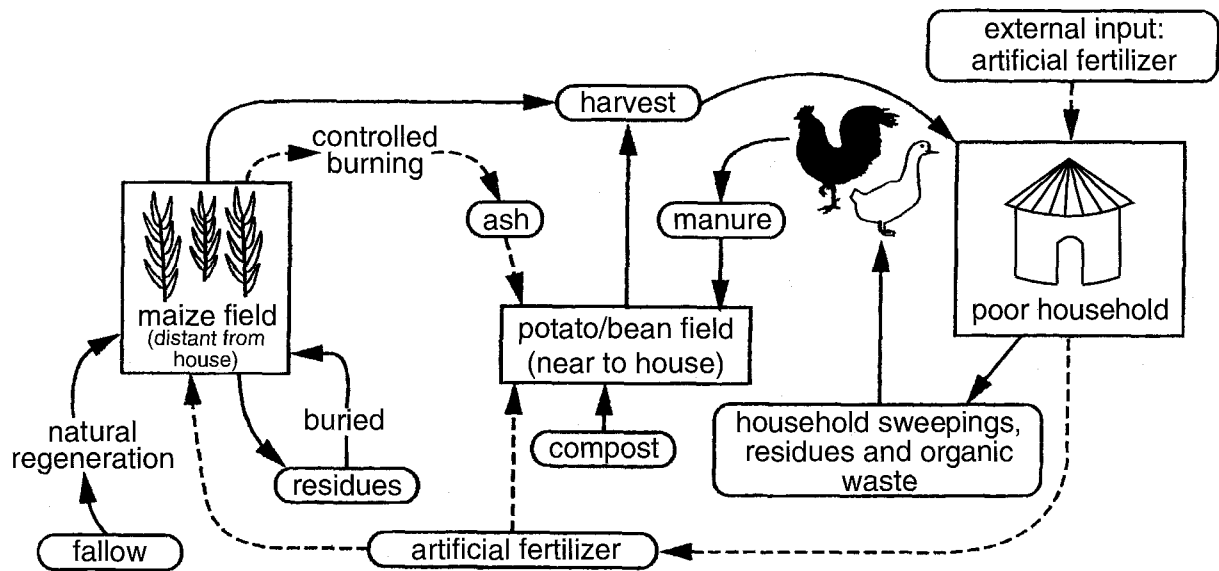

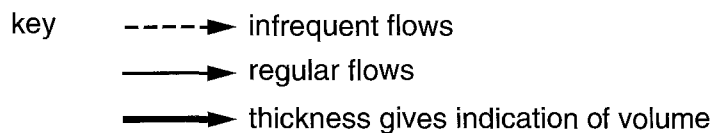
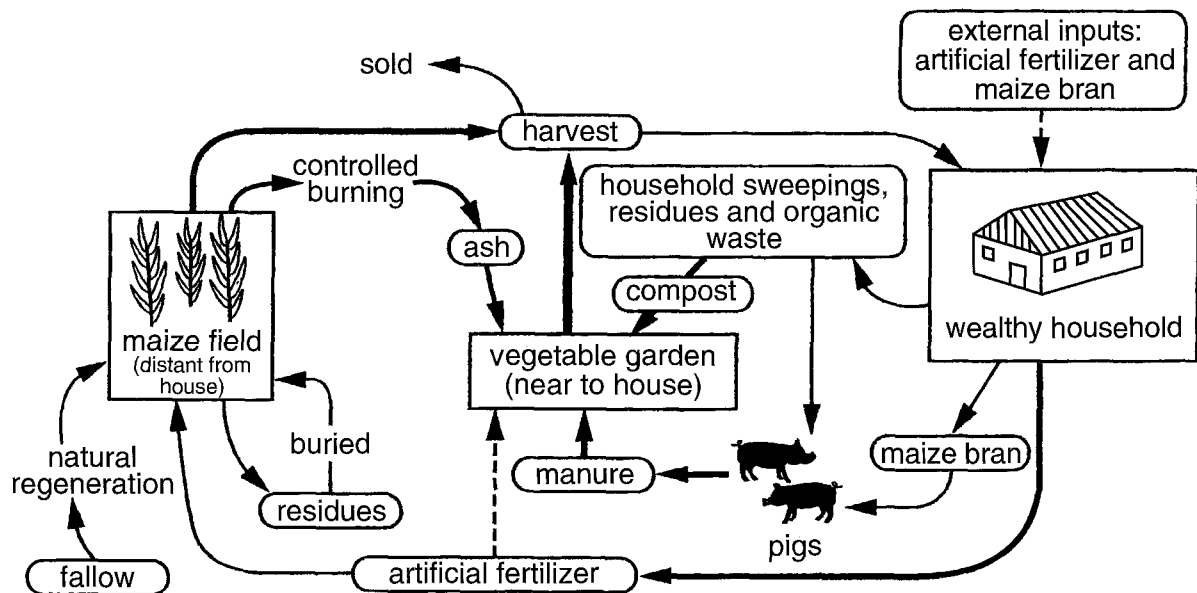
Figures 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and Tables 1, 2 are for use with Paper 3, Advanced Human Options.

A low income farm

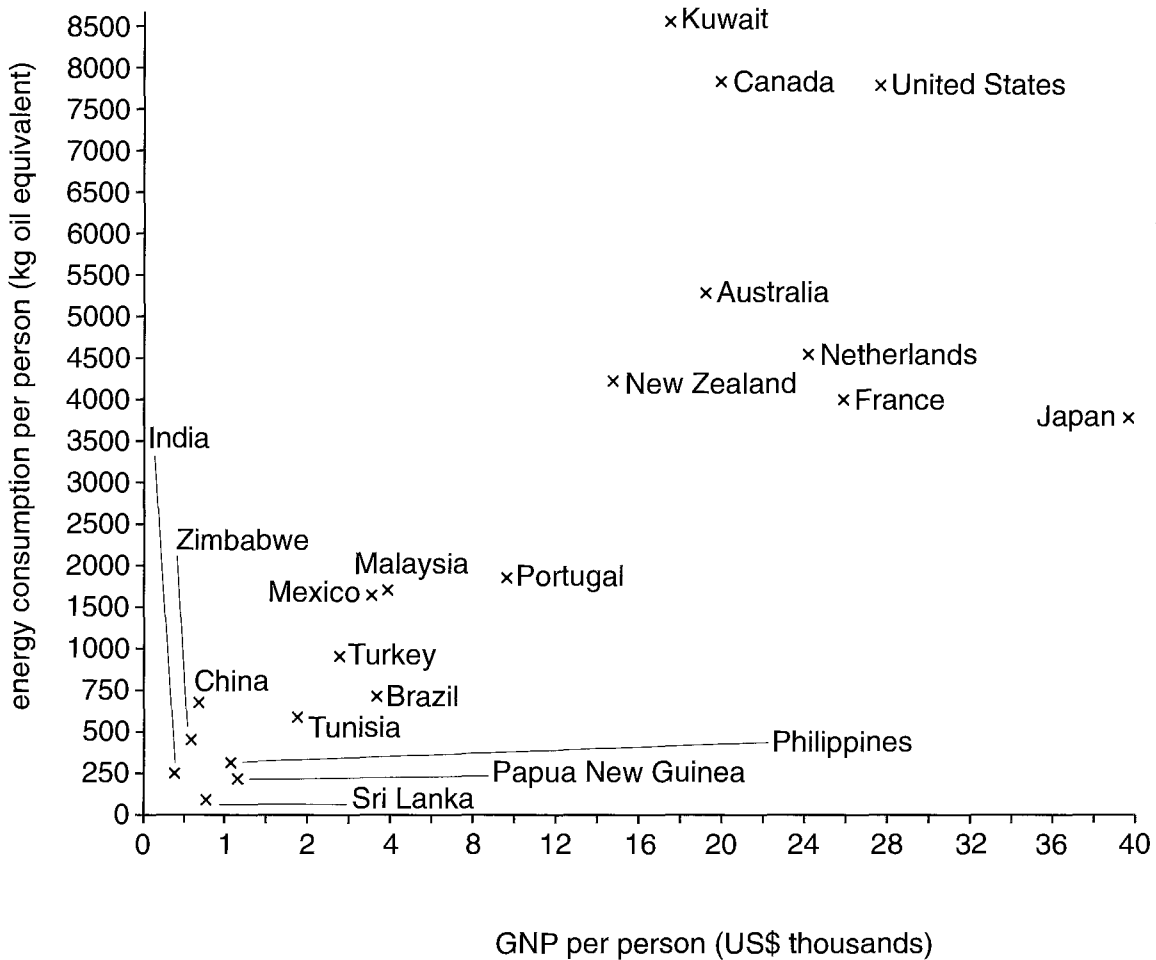


B higher income farm

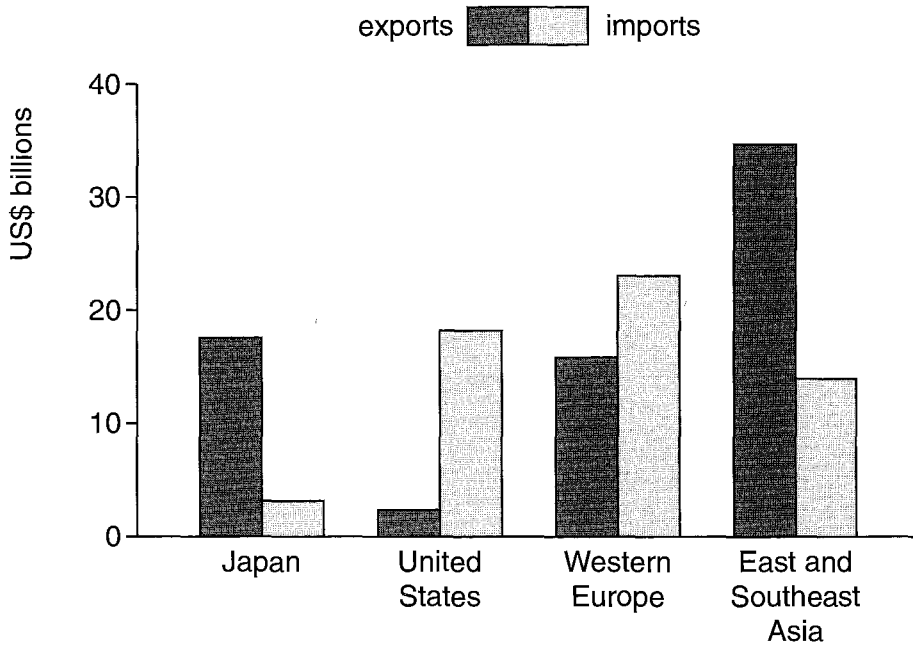

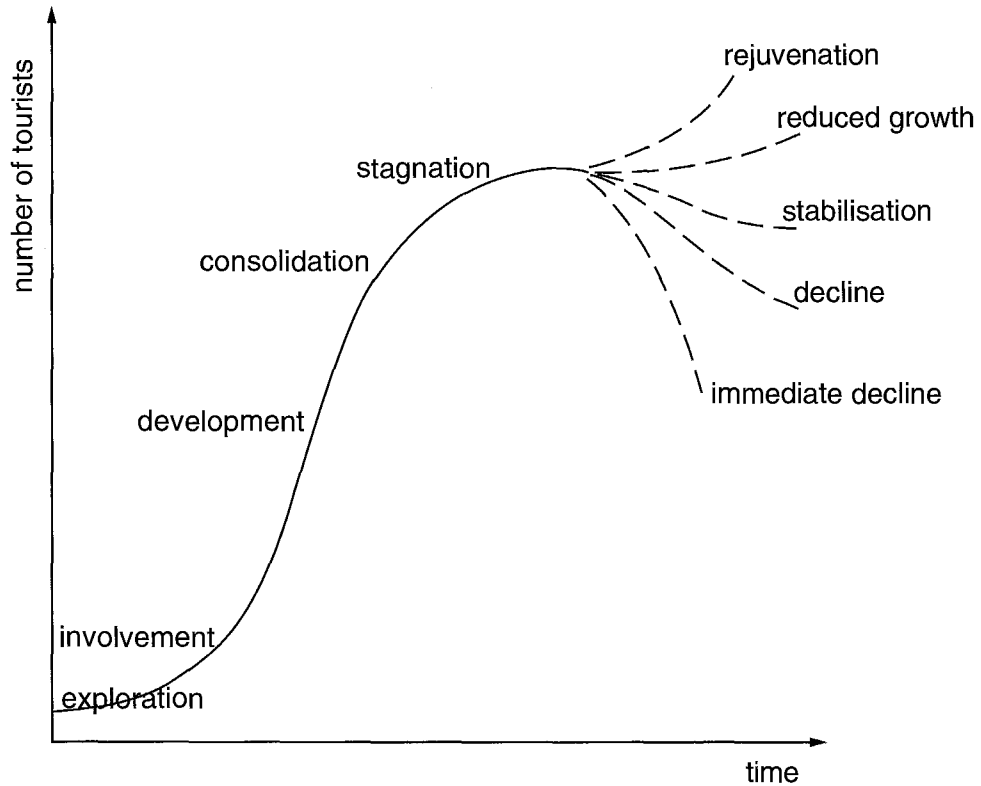

The balance of trade in consumer electronics for selected areas in 1994

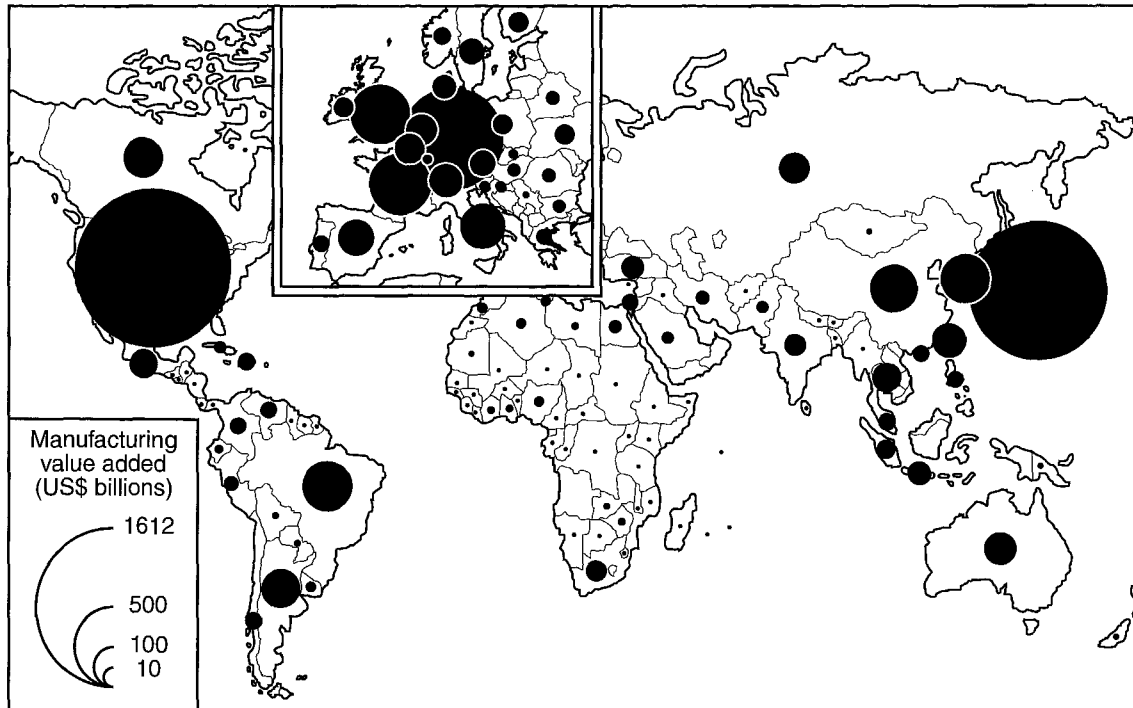
